1/4	i) Participation in job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.	On September 25th, 2024, Inner Banks Media Stations Participated in the East Carolina University Job and Internship Fair. Operations Manager Dylan McKay hosted the Inner Banks Media booth at the Greenville Convention Center. IBX designed a QR code to link to our IBX website employment page. The page contained PDF job applications and applications to take part in the Inner Banks Media internship program.
1/4		On March 2nd, 2025, Inner Banks Media Stations Participated in the East Carolina University School of Communications Job and Internship Fair. Operations Manager Dylan McKay hosted the Inner Banks Media booth on the main campus student center ballroom. Again we used a QR scan code to entice tech savvy students to our IBX website internship page.
1	ii) Hosting of Job Fair	Inner Banks Media partnered with Pitt Community College and the nonprofit Eastern North Carolina Alliance to host the "Better Skills, Better Jobs. Job Fair on October 3, 2024. This event took place at the Greenville Convention Center. We created a morning session for high schools only. 484 students from six area high schools bussed students to the job fair. The afternoon session was dedicated to the public at large. There was no charge to the 125 employers who set up booths or the 1,017 job seekers who attended. Inner Banks Media's booth was staffed all day by senior level management: Henry Hinton did a remote broadcast from site. Hank Hinton, Dylan McKay and Dann Miller split time to staff the booth all day.
1	v) Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.	Inner Banks Media continued our internship program with East Carolina University. The following interns were engaged over the last 12-month period from ECU: Christopher Watson, Jason Ingram, Brandon Turay, Andrew Howard and Cecilla Tidwell.
1/4	x) Participation in scholarship programs designed to encourage pursuit of a career in broadcasting.	Henry Hinton, President, donated \$1,000 to East Carolina University School of Communications to help provide scholarships for students interested in broadcasting.
